REGULAR MEETING

Mr. Boschult, Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

The first item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes of the May 9, 2006 Regular and Annual Meetings. Mr. Boschult asked if there were comments or corrections to the minutes. As there were none, Mr. Curry moved to approve the minutes of the May 9, 2006 Regular and Annual Meetings. Mr. Boschult seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

CONSIDERATION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO'S AMENDED APPLICATION FOR ROCKY MOUNTAIN RADIOACTIVE WASTE COMPACT APPROVAL OF A LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY CONCERNING THE CLEAN HARBORS DEER TRAIL FACILITY

This portion of the meeting was transcribed by a court reporter. A copy of the transcript can be ordered by sending a request, along with \$25.00, to the Rocky Mountain Low-Level Radioactive Waste Board.

The following summarizes the decisions made by the Board.

- The Board granted the State of Colorado's request to delay consideration of the amended application for a period of sixty days.
- The Board unanimously adopted the Resolution 2006 – 01, an enforcement moratorium on violations of the Compact or Board Rules arising from the disposal of in region generated water treatment residuals, striking "Radioactive" in the third line of the title.
- The Board approved a motion to consider allowing the Clean Harbors Deer Trail Facility to accept water treatment residuals during the course of the moratorium. Staff was directed to draft a resolution for a telephonic meeting to be held the following week. Mr. Curry voted against this motion.

**CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATION FROM THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER
TO EXPORT RADIUM WASTE**

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The following summarizes the decisions made by the Board.

After consideration the Board denied the City and County of Denver's Export Application. Mr. Curry voted against the motion denying the Application.

OTHER BUSINESS

Upon completion of Mr. Slosky's review of the Executive Director's Report, Mr. Boschult made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Curry seconded; the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 4:20 p.m.
